BACKGROUND

Introduction 5 Hydroxyindole acetic acid (5-HIAA) is a metabolite of serotonin that is excreted in the urine. Elevated levels of 5-Hydroxyindole acetic acid may indicate carcinoid tumour, while low levels may be associated with Cockayne Syndrome.
