

## PRODUCT INFORMATION

#### **Intended Use**

Quantitative determination of Human ST2/IL-1 RL1

## **General Description**

ABPR-ZB077 is a solid phase sandwich ELISA for quantitative determination of Human ST2/IL-1 RL1.

# **Reagents And Materials Provided**

- Capture Antibody: 1 mg/mL of mouse anti-Human IL1RL1/DER4 monoclonal antibody [CABT-ZB502] (in PBS, pH 7.4).
- Detection Antibody: 0.2 mg/mL of mouse anti-Human IL1RL1/DER4 monoclonal antibody [CABT-ZB874] conjugated to HRP (in PBS, 50 % HRP-Protector, pH 7.4, store at 4°C).
- Standard: Each vial contains 28 ng of recombinant Human IL1RL1/DER4.

# **Reconstitution And Storage**

#### Reconstitution

- Capture Antibody: Dilute to a working concentration of 2 µg/mL in PBS before coating.
- Detection Antibbody: Dilute to working concentration of 1.2 µg/mL in detection antibody dilution buffer before use.
- 3. Standard: Reconstitute with 1 mL detection antibody dilution buffer.

### Storage

- Capture Antibody: Aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Avoid 1. repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
- Detection Antibody: Store at 4°C and protect it from prolonged exposure to light for up to 6 months from 2. date of receipt. DO NOT FREEZE!
- Standard: Store lyophilized standard at -20°C to -80°C for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Aliquot and store the reconstituted Standard at -80°C for up to 1 month. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
