## PRODUCT INFORMATION

### Intended Use

Quantitative determination of Human CST6

### General Description

ABPR-ZB094 is a solid phase sandwich ELISA for quantitative determination of Human CST6.

### Reagents And Materials Provided

1. Capture Antibody: 1.0 mg/mL of rabbit anti-CST6 monoclonal antibody [CABT-ZB518].
2. Detection Antibody: 0.5 mg/mL mouse anti-CST6 monoclonal antibody [CABT-ZB888] conjugated to HRP.
3. Standard: Each vial contains 6 ng of recombinant CST6

### Reconstitution And Storage

#### Reconstitution

1. Capture Antibody: Dilute to a working concentration of 2 µg/mL in CBS before coating.
2. Detection Antibody: Dilute to working concentration of 0.5 µg/mL in detection antibody dilution buffer before use.
3. Standard: Reconstitute with 1 mL detection antibody dilution buffer.

#### Storage

1. Capture Antibody: Aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
2. Detection Antibody: Protect it from prolonged exposure to light. Aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C and for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
3. Standard: Store lyophilized standard at -20°C to -80°C for up to 6 months from date of receipt. Aliquot and store the reconstituted Standard at -80°C for up to 1 month. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

### Detection Range

Assay range: 7.81-500 pg/mL
