Storage	Store at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). Aliquot and store at -20°C (add glycerol to a final volume of 40% for extra stability). Avoid repeated freeze / thaw cycles.

BACKGROUND

Introduction The protein encoded by this gene is a single subunit E3 ubiquitin ligase. Laforin is

polyubiquitinated by the encoded; protein. Defects in this intronless gene lead to an accumulation of laforin and onset of Lafora disease, also known as; progressive myoclonic epilepsy type 2 (EPM2).
