BACKGROUND

Introduction	Endotoxins have a weight of around 10 kDa and their general structure consists of three parts: Lipid A, core oligosaccharide and O-specific polysaccharide, also called antigen-O. (fig. 1). The biosynthesis of LPS is strictly sequential with the core polysaccharides added sequentially to Lipid A. The subunits of the O-antigen are added last.
