Introduction	The Sin Nombre virus (roughly translated as "the nameless virus" in Spanish) (SNV) is the prototypical etiologic agent of hantavirus cardiopulmonary syndrome (HCPS). Its original name was "Four Corners virus" or "Navajo Flu", but the name was changed after local residents raised objections.
