BACKGROUND

Introduction

The alcohol soluble proteins (prolamins) from wheat, rye, barley and oats produce the harmful effect of coeliac disease or gluten sensitive enteropathy in humans by causing characteristic changes in the intestinal mucosa. Patients so affected must avoid eating these grains and replace them with rice, corn, potatoes, etc. Many gluten-free foods are produced industrially, thus several immunoassays have been developed for determination of gliadin in supposedly gluten-free foods.
