It works by blocking the production of a chemical called prostaglandin which the body produces in response to injury or certain diseases. Prostaglandins are responsible for causing swelling, pain and inflammation associated with these conditions. All the medicines in this group reduce inflammation caused by the body's own immune system and are effective pain killers. This particular NSAID is commonly used to treat the symptoms of migraine.
