<b>Product Overview</b>	Zolpidem, HRP conjugate
<b>Antigen Description</b>	Zolpidem is a hypnotic agent used in the treatment of insomnia. Known as a one of the "Z-drugs", they were initially thought to be less addictive and/or habit-forming than benzodiazepines. However, this appraisal has shifted somewhat in the last few years as cases of addiction and habituation have been presented.

<b>Introduction</b>	Zolpidem is an imidazo[1,2-a]pyridine compound having a 4-tolyl group at the 2-position, an N,N-dimethylcarbamoylmethyl group at the 3-position and a methyl substituent at the 6-position. It has a role as a central nervous system depressant, a GABA agonist and a sedative.
