BACKGROUND

Introduction	Hepatitis A is a highly contagious viral infection that affects the liver. It is caused by the hepatitis A virus (HAV) and can spread through contaminated food or water, close contact with an infected person, or by using drugs that contain the virus. Symptoms typically appear within 2-6 weeks after exposure and can include fever, fatigue, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, and dark urine. Hepatitis A is typically treated with rest, fluids, and, in some cases, medication. Vaccination is the best way to prevent hepatitis A infection.
