BACKGROUND

Introduction	Yersinia enterocolitica is a Gram-negative coccobacillus of which pathogenic serogroups, e.g. O:8, have been identified. Yersinia outer proteins (Yops) are key virulence factors during the infection of host cells. YopM is injected into the host cell's cytosol where it interferes with the regulation of translation by activating ribosomal S6 kinase.
