### PRODUCT INFORMATION

<b>Antigen Description</b>	Dinitolmide (or zoalene) is a fodder additive for poultry, used to prevent coccidiosis infections. It is usually sold under trade names such as Coccidine A, Coccidot, and Zoamix. As a broad-spectrum anticoccidial drug, it can prevent seven main strains of <i>Eimeria coccidium</i> and coccidiosis of domestic rabbits while leaves no residues in tissues.
