Antigen Description	Digoxin is a cardiac glycoside, which can inhibits the sodium potassium adenosine triphosphatase (ATPase) pump, thereby increasing intracellular calcium and enhancing cardiac contractility. It is named Lanoxin as a medication used to treat various heart condition, such as atrial fibrillation, atrial flutter, and heart failure. Digoxin is first extracted from the foxglove plant, Digitalis lanata, and now is the most effective and safe medicines needed in a health system.
