BACKGROUND

Introduction	The Epstein–Barrvirus (EBV), also called human herpesvirus 4 (HHV-4), is a virus of theherpes family, which includes herpes simplex virus 1 and 2, and is one of themost common viruses in humans. It is best known as the cause of infectiousmononucleosis. It is also associated with particular forms of cancer, particularly Hodgkin"s lymphoma, Burkitt"s lymphoma, nasopharyngealcarcinoma, and central nervous system lymphomas associated with HIV. Finally, there is evidence that infection with the virus is associated with a higher riskof certain autoimmune diseases, especially dermatomyositis, systemic lupuserythematosus, rheumatoid arthritis, Sjögren"s syndrome, and multiplesclerosis.
