Antigen Description	Tumor necrosis factor (TNF, cachexin or cachectin formerly known as tumor necrosis factor-alpha) is a cytokine involved in systemic inflammation and is a member of a group of cytokines that stimulate the acute phase reaction.
Specificity	Effective in inhibition of the biological activity of recombinant and natural TNF-alpha.

Applications	Inhibition of biological activity of TNF-alpha in different biological fluids. Detection of TNF-alpha in two-site immunoassay. Immunohistochemistry using formalin-fixed frozen tissues. Not tested with paraffin-embedded sections. Each laboratory should determine an optimum working titer for use in its particular application.
