



# Anti-TSPYL5 polyclonal antibody (DPAB-DC1142)

<b>Antigen Description</b>	TSPYL5 (TSPY-like 5) is a protein-coding gene. Diseases associated with TSPYL5 include lung squamous cell carcinoma, and acute myeloid leukemia. GO annotations related to this gene include protein binding. An important paralog of this gene is SET.
<b>Specificity</b>	Specific to recombinant protein GX1663. This antibody detects mTSPYL5 protein. It also recognizes human TSPYL5 protein.
<b>Immunogen</b>	Recombinant GST fusion protein corresponding to 245 amino acids of mouse Tspyl5.
<b>Isotype</b>	IgG
