Antigen Description	RAB3A (RAB3A, member RAS oncogene family) is a protein-coding gene. Diseases associated with RAB3A include choroideremia, and multiple system atrophy, and among its related superpathways are Synaptic Vesicle Pathway and Serotonin Neurotransmitter Release Cycle. GO annotations related to this gene include protein C-terminus binding and GTP binding. An important paralog of this gene is RAB10.
