Antigen Description	Amphiregulin is a member of the EGF family of cytokines, which is comprised of at least ten proteins including EGF, TGF-alpha, HB-EGF, and the various heregulins. All of these cytokines are synthesized as transmembrane precursors and are characterized by the presence of one or several EGF structural units in their extracellular domain.
Specificity	Detects mouse Amphiregulin in ELISAs and Western blots. In sandwich immunoassays, less than 1% cross-reactivity with recombinant human Amphiregulin is observed.
