BACKGROUND

Introduction	Citreoviridin is a mycotoxin isolated from several <i>Penicillium</i> species that has been shown to inhibit the mitochondrial ATP synthetase system. It inhibits soluble ATPase ($K_D = 4.1 \mu M$), ADP stimulated respiration in isolated rat liver mitochondria ($K_D = 0.15 \mu M$), and ATP-driven reduction of NAD^+ by succinate ($K_D = 2 \mu M$). Citreoviridin has been used to target ectopic ATPase activity in cancer cells in order to modulate the metabolic activity associated with tumorigenesis.
