C-reactive protein (CRP) is aprotein found in the blood, the levels of which rise in response toinflammation (i.e. C-reactive protein is an acute-phase protein). Itsphysiological role is to bind to phosphocholine expressed on the surface ofdead or dying cells (and some types of bacteria) in order to activate the complement system via the C1Q complex. CRP is synthesized by the liver inresponse to factors released by fat cells (adipocytes). It is a member of the pentraxin family of proteins. It is not related to C-peptide or protein C. C-reactive protein was the first pattern recognition receptor (PRR) to be identified.
