BACKGROUND

Introduction	Human papillomavirus (HPV) is a DNA virus from the papillomavirus family that is capable of infecting humans. Like all papillomaviruses, HPVs establish productive infections only in keratinocytes of the skin or mucous membranes. L1 is a major capsid protein of human papilloma virus. Infection with specific types of HPV has been associated with an increased risk of developing cervical neoplasia. Does not bind DNA.
