Intended Use

The Casein ELISA Kit is used to quantify levels of casein in raw and processed food, and uses an innovative extraction method to more accurately detect allergen levels.

Storage

Specimen Collection And Preparation

The casein protein must first be extracted from the food sample by adding 19mL of extraction solution to 1g of ground food. The mixture is then heated, at boiling for 10mins or the mixture shaken for 12 hours at room temperature. The mixture's pH then needs to be adjusted to 6-8. The supernatant is removed and then diluted 20 fold after centrifuging the sample at 3000g for 20 minutes.

Assay Procedure

1. Add 100 µL of extracted sample or standard into the desired microplate wells
2. Incubate 1 hour at room temperature
3. Wash plate
4. Add 100 µL of enzyme conjugate
5. Incubate 30 minutes at room temperature
6. Wash plate
7. Add 100 µL of substrate solution
8. Incubate 30 minutes at room temperature
9. Add 100 µL of stop solution and measure OD at 450/630 nm
