Antigen Description	Platelet factor 4 (PF4) is a member of the CXC chemokine family. Human and mouse PF4 share 64% identity. PF4 is involved in monocyte survivial and differentiation into macrophages, and it has anti-angiogenic activity.
Specificity	Detects human CXCL4/PF4 in ELISAs and Western blots. In sandwich immunoassays, less than 0.05% cross-reactivity with recombinant mouse PF4, recombinant human (rh) GRO alpha, and rhGRO beta is observed.
